Baldur School:

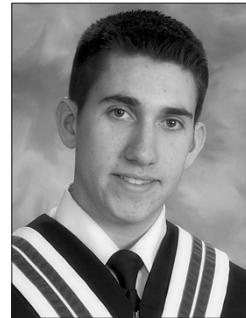

Bram Gates – Devos Family Scholarship, \$1,500 – to a student who will be attending University.



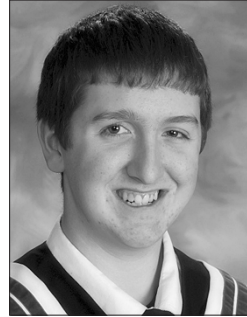

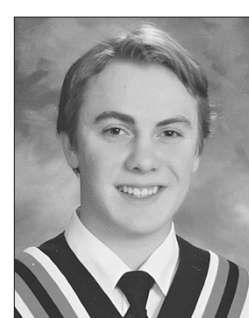

■ KEN & SHIRLEY DOWD SUPPORT THE CEMETERY FUND

In 2011 an endowment fund in the Glenboro Foundation designated to the Perpetual Care of the Glenboro Cemetery was established. Among the donors to the fund at that time were Ken and Shirley Dowd. Late in 2015, the Dowd's made another generous donation, building the fund considerably.

Ken's involvement with the cemetery began in 1977 when as a councillor for the RM of South Cypress he was appointed to the committee. In 1983, although no longer a councillor, he was appointed by the Village of Glenboro and has been one of the three member committee ever since.

In 1993, with funds remaining from the Dowd Family Reunion, Ken saw to the placement of an ornate gate at both Glenboro and Glencoe cemeteries.

In recent years with the help of Foundation grants, municipal support as well as generous public donations the cemetery committee has been able to move ahead with many improvement projects including straightening stones, trimming and cutting trees as required and planting new ones.
