2017 is a year to celebrate! Canada is marking 150 years. It is also the 30th Anniversary of the formation of The Glenboro Area Foundation Inc. The endowment fund of The Foundation was opened with a \$100 donation and has grown slowly but steadily to just over 1.5 million dollars. These funds are invested in perpetuity with annual grants returned to the community. The first granting in 1992 was \$ 100 to Glenboro Minor Sports and \$250 to the RM of South Cypress for the Patricia School Cairn maintenance and a new playground fund. Thirty years later, based on 2016 investment income from designated and undesignated funds, grants and scholarships will amount to just over \$60,000.

At the beginning, about 1985, a sub committee of the Chamber of Commerce, with support from the RM of South Cypress and the Village of Glenboro, was formed to investigate the formation of a Community Foundation. Fred Stevens, Stan Oleson and Roy Wallis, with assistance from Killarney lawyer Keith Heming, put together the necessary paperwork. The Constitution for The Glenboro Area Foundation Inc. was signed on January 23rd, 1987, "for the good of the Glenboro area". Incorporation was received in 1986 and the tax exempt status as a registered public foundation was received in 1988.

The first Board meeting was held in May of 1988 when the officers elected were John Moore, chairman; Herman Arason, vice-chairman; directors Eugene Ehnes, Jack Hamilton, Bill Shackel, Ellis Drinkwater, Fred Stevens, and Roy Wallis, secretary- treasurer.

Over the years, many donations, both large and small, have been received to celebrate family events or milestones, in memory of loved ones, to support a favourite endowment fund, or "just because", to both designated and undesignated funds. Grants have been awarded to support health care and education, emergency services, seniors and youth, sports and recreation, culture, space beautification, religion and more.

The growth of Glenboro's Foundation has been due to the generosity and tremendous support of many, many people including Evi and Helen Paulson, John and Vesta Scott, the family of Stewart and Eva Hamilton, George and Verna Notman, John Harvard, Lorelie Mitchell/Piet van Dijken, Ken and Shirley Dowd, the Glenboro Donor's Choice program, families who have contributed to the high school scholarships and the list goes on.

At the December 8th, 1998 meeting of The Foundation Board it was decided to invest the endowment funds with The Winnipeg Foundation, Glenboro being the first rural foundation to avail themselves of this service. The Glenboro Board is most appreciative of the support of the Winnipeg Foundation, the Thomas Sill Foundation, the Municipality of Glenboro South Cypress (formerly the RM of South Cypress and the Village of Glenboro), and area businesses.

The current board of the Glenboro Foundation looks forward to the continued growth of the endowment funds with resulting annual grants "for the good of the Glenboro area".

Chairman Ron Jefferies says: "WOW! \$60,000 in grants. What a boost to our Community and Area. Only now am I realizing the tremendous value The Glenboro Area Foundation brings to its residents. The founders (30 years ago) would be so proud. The sky is the limit for the Foundation, with the help and participation of the community. Great things can happen. We can be proud of our Foundation. So lets get involved and spread the word."

## ■ YOUTH IN PHILANTHROPY REPORT

Youth in Philanthropy is a program designed to introduce young people to the concept of caring for your fellow man. The Glenboro Foundation has a Youth in Philanthropy endowment fund and a group of students at the school working under the guidance of a school teacher(s) and a Foundation board member. They learn about raising funds for their endowment fund, to research eligible community projects or groups and make a decision for distributing the annual fund interest as a community grant. This year the students have decided to split their grant funds of \$437 to the Health Action Committee and to Glenboro School Financial Aid Fund.

Michelle Ruston, with support from an RBC Canada 150 grant, has initiated a day of activities in the community including a movie marathon, games, food and auction, a program she calls Brighter Futures. The proceeds will be going to the Health Action Committee for their recruitment of medical personnel for the hospital and area, as will the YIP grant.

The Glenboro School Financial Aid Fund is a fund at Glenboro School that assists students that cannot afford extracurricular activities, field trips or other activities in the community.
